- **Greenwood Women's Care Grant** which is a part of the Greenwood Community Foundation. The award amount is a minimum of \$1,000 and a max of \$10,000. This grant is being pursued to support the NFP program since this is the most expensive program that we have within our department, but also because we lost funding from First Steps Saluda and Edgefield this fiscal year. The deadline for this grant is August 31, 2024. Grant funding determinations will be made in October 2024. This is a 1-year grant.
- HRSA ECD Grant

 - supports HealthySteps program and Pediatric Care Coordinators at all pediatric sites

 - -Award amount: \$1,292,751
