# Operations

# ECS

- **Greenwood Women's Care Grant** which is a part of the Greenwood Community Foundation. The award amount is a minimum of \$1,000 and a max of \$10,000. This grant is being pursued to support the NFP program since this is the most expensive program that we have within our department, but also because we lost funding from First Steps Saluda and Edgefield this fiscal year. The deadline for this grant is August 31, 2024. Grant funding determinations will be made in October 2024. This is a 1-year grant. **We received \$5000.**
- **Parents as Teachers** celebrated 40 years on November 8th, which is also known as National PAT Day. The City of Greenwood Mayor, Brandon Smith, signed the Proclamation for National Parents as Teachers Day to recognize and proclaim November 8th as a day to encourage Parent Teacher Organizations and families in Greenwood to join forces to support children in the community in their educational goals.
