

## President's Report to the Board of Directors

Monday, October 26, 2020

- Protecting the 340B Program remains at the top of the advocacy agenda
  - What has occurred in the last month:
    - NACHC filed suit against HHS on Tuesday, October 21<sup>st</sup>
    - NPRM on the Executive Order released due date: October 26<sup>th</sup>
    - GOP committee leadership issued RFI comments due October 30<sup>th</sup>
    - Coalition of State Attorney Generals continued to expand
    - Bi-partisan House members issued letter to HHS protesting a rebate versus upfront discount model – additional members of Congress encouraged to sign-on
  - Related CHC/SV activity:
    - Served as reviewer on multiple drafts of the legal complaint prior to filing
    - Dr. Mellette submitted a declaration in support of the law suit/SV reviewed
    - Co-authored NACHC's official response to the NPRM
    - Primary author on response to GOP leadership RFI
    - Provided briefings for WI, TX, CT, VA, KS and SC health centers
    - Provided national briefing in conjunction with NACHC FOM/IT Conference
    - Authored script for CEO video messaging
    - Weekly meetings of advocacy/communications team
    - Serving as SME on national Twitter chat scheduled for Wednesday, October 28<sup>th</sup> beginning at 2:00 PM
- Health Center Funding remains a priority but no movement is likely until after the election
